### THE CHARGES:

## Launching a War of Aggression Against Iraq


During the Nuremberg trials of Nazi regime leaders following World War II, it was established that engaging in wars of aggression was to be considered the most serious crime under international law. This was enshrined in the United Nations Charter and applies to every nation in the world. Bush clearly broke this law in waging war on Iraq without credible evidence or justification, which has now claimed upwards of 1 Million Iraqi lives and over 4000 US Service men and women.

# 2. Illegal Detention of Prisoners of War

Under the so-called "War on Terror" the Bush Administration has created a new, illegal category for prisoners captured during combat called "enemy combatants". His regime used this category to justify holding prisoners without charge in facilities such as Guantanamo Bay and Abu Ghraib detaining them indefinitely, denying them the right to habeas corpus recognized in every modern and just judicial system and enshrined in international law.

# 3. The Use of Torture Against Prisoners of War

Official documents confirm the authorization of the use of torture by Bush's Secretary of Defense Donald Rumsfeld, indicating consent at the highest level of authority in the Bush Administration and in direct violation of the Geneva Conventions to which the United States is a signatory.
