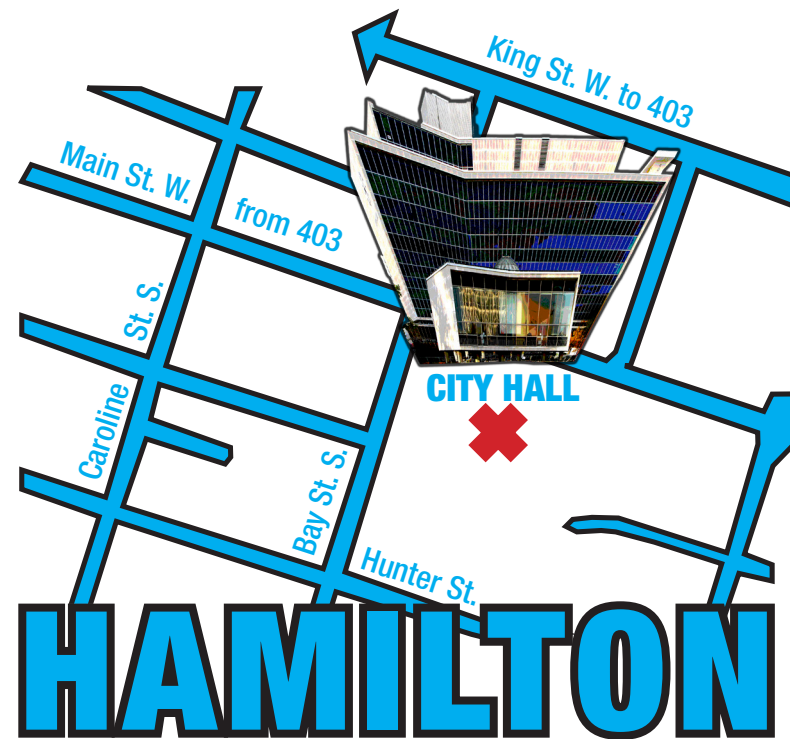


People vs U.S. Steel Rally
